# Pre-K Statewide Spreadsheet

- **Pre-K Statistics** – How many 3- or 4-year-olds are eligible but not enrolled in pre-k? Is the median class size more than 18? Is the teacher-to-child ratio more than 1:10? Where is the opportunity for quality child care programs to support?
- **Kindergarten Readiness** – What percentage of children in the district are ready? How many of them attended pre-k? Does the school district need support in this area? If so, how can partnerships be part of the solution?
- **HB 3 Waivers** – Which school districts are unable to provide full-day pre-k for 4-year-olds? How can't they offer this? How long is their waiver? (This year is last year for filing waivers.) Did they receive any partnership proposals? Are they partnering with child care? Can you help them?
- **Head Start Enrollment** – helps you understand where some 3- and 4-year-olds might be receiving early childhood education

# Child Care By The Numbers

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- **Texas Rising Star Statistics** – How many TRS providers are in my area? How has this changed over time? What is the percentage of all subsidy providers? How many child care homes are TRS?
- **Subsidy Statistics** – How many providers are in the subsidy program? How many centers vs. homes?
- **Child Statistics** – How many children in the subsidy program are in TRS programs? What are the average number of children by age served in the subsidy program?

# More Data Questions

- **801 Reports** – For complex analyses: Where do our families live and where are they choosing child care? How many of the families we serve are headed by single parents? On average, how many children does each family have in care?
- **State Plan**– What are TWC’s priorities? What type of issues is TWC addressing/funding?
- **Market Rate Survey** – What are average prices parents are paying? What’s that compared to the percentage of income?
- **Child Care Availability** – Who is participating in the Availability Portal? How many seats are available for infants?
- **TRS Calculator** – How much more money could a child care provider earn by being TRS?
- **Pre-K Partnerships Calculator** – When negotiating pre-k partnership details (formal), what can the provider take on vs. the public school partner? What age group or mix of children works best financially?

## Ready Schools

- Class size/ratios
- Staff workforce data (demographics, credentials)

- Prekindergarten and kindergarten assessment data
