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## **Context: Madison, WI**



# Dane County Population: 536,000

# City of Madison Population: 255,000

# Kids under age 5 = 30,300

# 9% (2,718) experiencing poverty



## **United Way of Dane County**

### **EDUCATION**

- Children are cared for and have fun as they become prepared for school.
- Students succeed academically and graduate from high school prepared for college, career and community.

#### INCOME

- More people are on pathways out of poverty.
- There is a decrease in family homelessness.

### HEALTH

- Reduce racial health disparities in Dane County.
- Increase resiliency and trauma supports for Dane County residents.



#### **2GEN (MULTIGENERATIONAL APPROACH)**

Build family well-being by intentionally and simultaneously working with children under five and the adults in the their lives together.

## **Education: Born Learning Strategies**

- 1. Parents supported in how to be their child's first teacher.
- 2. Holistic family supports focused on 13 geographic areas.
- Children screened for developmental delays, families receive support for potential delays. (ASQ data sharing and referral)
- 4. Community of practice to support professionals Home Visitors.
- 5. Healthcare professionals knowledgeable and connected to community supports.





## Using Data to Advance Early Childhood Outcomes

#### Intentional in funding and aligning metrics:

 RFP's for investments/funding – involve each entity (volunteers and/or staff) in the decisionmaking process for alignment

#### Funding for School Aged Care during Pandemic Response

 Created identical characteristics for funding from the City of Madison, the Madison Metropolitan School District and United Way of Dane County

#### Finding Ways to Share Data: Comprehensive Plan for Early Childhood

- Creation of alignment in strategy in the development of the Comprehensive Plan for Early
  Childhood
- Collective decision-making process on outcomes
- Pandemic impact on implementation
- Now an example of a good strategic plan in the Early Childhood State Systems Building Resource Guide.
